3. **Aqeedah** - Islamic Creed
4. **Tafseer** - Exegesis of the Qur'an
5. **Fiqh al-Sirah** - Understanding the Life of the Prophet ﷺ
6. **Mustalah al-Hadith** - The Science of Hadith Transmission and Classification
7. **Hadith** - A study of the meaning and explanation of Ahadiths
8. **Ulum al-Qur'an** - Sciences of the Noble Qur'an
9. **Tarbeyah** - Purification of the Heart and Soul and ennoblement of Character

Assessment

Regular assessment will be conducted throughout the course to ensure students have acquired the necessary knowledge and expertise. Students will be issued with a certificate in Islamic Studies depending on their assessment results, attendance and punctuality.
